On December 3, the Cameroon army lost three of its members at the security post in Jakiri market, Bui Division of the North West Region. The Bui Warriors have claimed responsibility for the Killings.

President NW House of Chiefs Kidnapped

A source close to the palace told Mimi Mefo Info (MMI) that the traditional ruler was picked up by separatist fighters on Tuesday December 7th, from his Palace. His Royal Highness, Fon Shomitang II, the traditional ruler of Mbaw Yakum fondom doubles as the President of the North West House of Chiefs.

Military Summarily Executes a man in public

It is alleged that on December 08, 2021, the military executed a man in Ntarinkon, Bamenda around 6:50 pm. A witness told Mimi Mefo Info that the victim was pulled out of the armored car which was also stuck in traffic amongst other cars, and summarily executed in public. "I don't know who the man was or what crime he had committed," a witness said.

Same day there were sporadic shottings at hospital roundabout and at the end, two corpses were lying around hospital roundabout.

Suspected separatists burn down house of former Mamfe mayor

Suspected separatists fighters have burned down the house of former Mamfe mayor Mr Ayuk John Takunchong. It is alleged his home was set ablaze due to an audio message he made currently circulating on social media in which he accused a Separatist leader of human rights violations.

One Separatist Fighter Killed

One of the Kidnappers who have been terrorizing the people of Menteh in Mike 4 Nkwen Bamenda has been beaten to death by the people of that neighborhood. Reports say the gang of three stormed the home of a resident of that area on December 1, 2021, and took a woman away after waiting for her husband in vain at about 7:30 pm. They reportedly mounted the bike they came with and took off when an alarm was raised by a passer-by who saw how the woman was being forced on the bike.
